Since 1961, SADIO (Argentine Society for Informatics) organizes each year the Argentine Conference on Computer Science and Operations Research, JAIIO (Jornadas Argentinas de Informática e Investigación Operativa). JAIIO is one of the most relevant events for the national and regional IT sector, with participants from both industry and academia. JAIIO is organized as a series of thematic symposia including topics such as software engineering, artificial intelligence, technology, agroinformatics, high performance computing, industrial informatics, free software, law, health and information society. In 2010, the 39th JAIIO will be held at Buenos Aires (Argentina) from August 30th to September 3rd.

In the past two decades, information security has become a relevant area of every organization and a vital component of any computer system. As such, information security is now recognized as an independent, though transversal in origin, research field. In 2009, a new symposium was presented in the 38th JAIIO: the Workshop on Information Security (WSegI). The main goal of the workshop is to bring together experts on computer security and to generate a space for the dynamic and free exchange of ideas, experiences and projects in the area.

WSegI is an opportunity to present **research dealing with theoretical or practical matters in information security**. Authors of accepted papers will be invited to present their results during the workshop. At least one of the authors of an accepted paper must be registered to the conference in order to insure its publication in the JAIIO Proceedings.

Scope

Topics of interest include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Cryptography, cryptanalysis and secure protocols.
- Access control and authentication. Biometrics.
- Intrusion detection.
- Botnets.
- Virus, malware and spam.
- Social network security.
- Information security in the semantic web.
- Application security.
- Static and dynamic code analysis.
- Forensics.
- e-Business. e-Voting and digital documents. Identity theft.

Manuscript submission

- Manuscripts must be submitted (in PDF format) through the OCS system before May 3rd. 2010.
- Authors must indicate whether the manuscript might be presented simultaneously in another symposium.
- The maximum length of a full paper is 15 pages (A4 paper size), including a short abstract of no more than 200 words.
